






















	Introducing my thinking when creating works through a collection of cat works that I have created in the past. 15cm or larger
	24cm
	3.75cm (1/4 of 15cm) x 15cm Preferably foil paper. Tweezers. An arrangement of "Solitaire Diamond" by Miyuki Kawamura.
	15cm
	15cm Eyeball sticker (if available) For koala, we recommend paper with the same color on both sides, such as Tanto.
	15cm
	15 - 24cm
	15cm I plan to fold both versions, with and without the backs coming out if we have time.
	B4 paper, Pencil, Scissors I will teach one more model if we have time.
	15cm
	24cm or larger and 15cm Cutter (for cutting square into rectangles)
	2 sheets of 15cm. Bone folder Since we will make a lot of creases, it is best to use common kami paper at first.
	Teacher will be distributing materials to Avance participants. Half a newspaper for "Cat ears", 4 sheets of A4 paper for "Sword". If we have time, one sheet of 15cm and some black paper for "Finger puppet". Glue.

	4 white sheets of 15cm, 2 non-white sheets of 15cm for practice and 1 sheet of 7.5cm. Ruler, cutter, cutter mat (all required). There is a pattern print data for the spider, so please print it on a 15cm square yellow paper and cut it into 4 pieces of 7cm square (not 7.5cm square). Avance participants can purchase paper sets at the venue.
	15cm Duo color paper Something sharp like a toothpick
	35cm or larger. Glue (It is not necessary, but it will be helpful). Distribute crease pattern in case we can't finish in time. The crease pattern will be displayed with the work, so please use it as a reference to join the class.

	27cm Duo color paper. Ruler, Pencil, Double-sided tape. Start by folding the edges of the paper into 1/18 equal wide. For 27cm paper, fold 1.5cm, for 24cm paper, fold 1.33cm, and for 35cm paper, fold 1.94cm.
	15cm or larger

	17.5cm
	4 sheets of 15cm duo color paper Paper cutter. Make creases on the square paper and then cut it into rectangles.
	5 sheets of square paper The diagrams are provided.
	15cm
	17.5cm is recommended, but 15cm is also OK. Tweezers. I will not teach how to fold a doll stand during the class.
	15cm
	Flower: 7.5cm (duo color of red and yellow if available), leaves: 7.5cm
	Several sheets of 7.5cm Glue, Scissors
